He holds a 1993 PhD in Educational Administration, from Southern Illinois University at Carbondale, and was a Dissertation Research Award recipient and Doctoral Fellow. Cited in Who's Who in America as an expert in distance and virtual learning, Dr. Clark is the author or co-author of numerous studies as well as professional articles, and the books *Distance Education: The Foundations of Effective Practice* (Jossey-Bass, 1991) and *Virtual Schools: Planning for Success* (Teachers College Press, 2005).

From 2000-2005, Dr. Clark served as primary evaluator of the \$9.1 million STAR project, funded by a grant from the U. S. Department of Education Star Schools Program.
